

Don't forget to use capital letters and full stops in your sentences.</p>	<p>RE – Judaism</p> <p>Thinking of the 10 commandments in Judaism, write a set of rules that you believe would help someone live a happy life.</p>	<p>Maths –</p> <p>Challenge yourself to count up to and back from 50.</p> <p>Can you write all the numbers up to 50?</p> <p>Can you count in 10's up to 50?</p> <p>Can you caunt in 5's up to 50?</p> <p>Can you count in 2's up to 50?</p>
