This term we will continue to teach the Year 3 curriculum, as well as continually assessing and filling in any gaps from the previous learning.

You will find a brief overview of the curriculum content for English and Maths as well as support for your child's well-being. Information about other subjects will be sent separately in a more detailed 'Knowledge Organiser'. This information is designed to give you a flavour of what the children in Year 3 will be learning this term as well as some more detailed information on the knowledge we expect children to know at the end of this term.

English

We continue this term using the Pied Piper of Hamelin as our high quality text. Children will be writing in lots of different styles throughout this unit and have many opportunities to use grammar and punctuation in their writing. At the end of the unit, children will write a persuasive piece of writing based upon what they have learned.

We will then move onto our final unit of the Autumn term, which will be based upon a wishing text and the high quality text, The Lost Homework by Richard O'Neill.

Children will have allocated reading time each day and will be using Accelerated Reader to do quizzes on books they have read. Please ensure children bring their reading book and planner to school every day.

We will be using Read Write Inc for spellings. Children will be introduced to a spelling rule each Monday and consolidate their learning through completing various activities during their daily spelling lessons.



Maths

We continue this term learning how to use the formal written method of column addition and subtraction including consolidating our knowledge about when and how to exchange tens and hundreds. Children have the opportunity to use concrete apparatus and pictorial representations to support their learning at all times.

We then move onto learning about multiplication and division.
The focus this term will be consolidating our knowledge about arrays and the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

Timetables are taught every day during our maths lesson.
Children will be working on their 3, 4 and 8 X tables as well as consolidating their 2, 5 and 10's. Our primary focus this term is dividing by 4. The Tackling Tables website and app and www.timestables.co.uk can support this learning at home.
Children will have an arithmetic test every Friday- this helps to identify and address gaps in learning. We also spend time looking at word problem and reasoning questions, discussing what the question is asking and how we go about solving it.



PSHE Curriculum

We will be teaching weekly PHSE sessions aimed at nurturing your child's mental health and well-being. The focus of our PSHE lessons this term is Celebrating Difference. Children will consider how each person is unique and special. We will also think about bullying and the consequences of such behaviour as well as learning how to resolve conflict.

During the Autumn term, we will be continually assessing your child's knowledge and we will target our teaching towards filling any gaps at the start of each lesson

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
