This term we will teach the Year 5 curriculum, as well as continually assessing and filling in any gaps from their previous learning.

This information is designed to give you a flavour of what the children in Year 5 will be learning this term as well as some more detailed information on the knowledge we expect children to know at the end of this term.

### **English**

In English this half term, Year 5 will be learning to write a Journey Tale whilst learning the model text 'The Forest' through Talk 4 Writing methods. Year 5 will develop an understanding of the key features needed in writing a journey tale, they will then innovate on the model text before 'inventing' and writing their own. The class text we will be reading this half term is 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna. In class, Year 5 are focussing on weekly RWINc Spelling Units as well as some Year 5 Statutory Spellings. Year 5 will be consolidating aspects of previously learned grammar this half term before developing further knowledge with apostrophe use, verb tenses and sentence types. Throughout the term, we will continue to 'gap-fill' areas of teaching and learning from previous years. This will be done through assessment to inform teaching.



#### Maths

In Maths this half term, Year 5 will be learning Multiplication and Division before moving onto Fractions.

This will include: methods of multiplication and division, understanding factors, prime numbers as well as square / cubed numbers. The fractions unit will develop Year 5's knowledge of adding and subtracting fractions, equivalency and problem solving. There are additional challenge activities on hand each lesson to promote reasoning, problem solving and fluency skills. Maths will be taught through the mastery approach with White Rose Maths.

In Year 5 your child will have daily mental arithmetic sessions, gap fill sessions as well as a daily multiplication grid to practise their times tables.

In Maths throughout the term we will continue to 'gap-fill' any areas of teaching and learning necessary. This will be done through assessment to inform teaching.
