




We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this half term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings, maths and English homework that are set each week.

<p>History - The Romans</p>  <p>Find out about the significance of the Roman army to its success when attacking and defending areas.</p> <p>Write a diary entry about life in the army.</p>	<p>Science - Animal classification</p>  <p>Find out about animals from each of the classifications.</p> <p>Draw a labelled diagram of an insect, bird, mammal, amphibian, fish or reptile.</p>	<p>Geography - Spatial Sense</p>  <p>Find out how maps help us scale down a very large area.</p> <p>Create a map of the local area, including grid lines and references.</p>
<p>Computing- eSafety</p>  <p>Design a poster to promote e-safety.</p> <p>Write a set of e-safety rules that could be shared with all children in the school.</p>	<p>RE - Buddhism</p>  <p>Find out about the teachings of Buddha.</p> <p>Create a comic strip explaining a day in the life of a Buddhist, showing some of the routines and teachings they follow.</p>	<p>PSHE - Being me</p>  <p>Write an autobiography about your life so far.</p> <p>Draw a self portrait or create a piece of 3D art to represent yourself. Make sure you can talk about it.</p>
