<p><u>History - Baghdad</u></p> <p>Create a poster to advertise the exciting new city of Baghdad.</p> <p>Write a diary entry as a Mongol who invades Baghdad in 1258.</p>	<p><u>Science - Biology</u></p> <p>Create a 3D model of an organ of your choice - remember to label it.</p> <p>Find out about the life of a famous scientist and create a fact file or write a biography or autobiography about their life.</p>	<p><u>Geography - Spatial Sense</u></p> <p>Draw a map of your route to school including symbols and a key.</p> <p>Create a leaflet that includes one interesting fact about each of the 7 continents. You can include pictures and drawings.</p>
<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Design a poster to promote e-safety.</p> <p>Write a set of e-safety rules that could be shared with all children in the school.</p>	<p><u>RE - Christianity</u></p> <p>Find out about the history of the Bible.</p> <p>Create a comic strip or write a newspaper article for a story from the Bible.</p>	<p><u>PSHE - Being me</u></p> <p>Write an autobiography about your life so far.</p> <p>Draw a self portrait or create a piece of 3D art to represent yourself. Make sure you can talk about it.</p>
