Remember le=un and la =une. You can also colour in the worksheet.</p> <p>You only have to choose 1 worksheet!</p> 	<p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>Design an anti-bullying poster. Show people what they can do to get help if they are being bullied. Use the attached posters to give you some ideas.</p>
