RE - Buddhism



Find out about the Buddhism way of life using the 8-fold path.

Create a fact file, booklet or poster presenting your information.

PSHE -Relationships

Understand the different relationships we are part of and learning how to deal with difficult emotions within those relationships.

Produce a piece of inspirational work based on the PSHE theme.

This could be a story, a poem or a piece of art work.

The challenge work is due in on the week beginning Monday 20th May 2024 to show to the class on Tues 21st May at 3pm. Parents/ Carers are invited in at this time to see the work produced. The above ideas represent a range of work for the subjects that your child will cover this half term.
