We would like children to select **at least one** of the homework challenges below for this half term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular Reading, Spellings, Maths and English homework that are set each week.

<p>History - King Charles II, the Plague and the Fire of London 1666.</p>  <p>Investigate the key figures and events of this time.</p> <p>Write a Newspaper article about one of these events.</p>	<p>Science - Electricity</p> <p>Find out about how circuits are formed.</p>  <p>Create a working buzzer game or quiz board where you match answers to light up the bulb!</p>	<p>Geography -South West England</p>  <p>Find out about the landscape and key places of the South West.</p> <p>Create an annotated 2d or 3d map of the area (this could be edible too !!)</p>
<p>ICT- Spreadsheets</p>  <p>Find out about why spreadsheets and graphs are so useful.</p> <p>Create a spreadsheet for a party, including the cost of everything you will need from balloons to birthday cake!</p>	<p>RE - Buddhism</p>  <p>Find out about the Buddhism way of life.</p> <p>Create a fact file , booklet or poster presenting your information.</p>	<p> PSHE -Relationships</p> <p>Understand the different relationships we are part of and learning how to deal with difficult emotions within those relationships.</p> <p>Produce a piece of inspirational work based on the PSHE theme. This could be a story, a poem or a piece of art work.</p>
