### Homework Challenge - Autumn 1 2023

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to run alongside the reading, spellings, maths and English homework that are set each week.

<p><b>Art - Colour</b> Tell an adult about the primary and secondary colours. Create either a hot or cold picture using the colour wheel (only use the colours on the hot/cold side of the wheel!)</p> 	<p><b>Science - The Human Body</b> Draw a picture of yourself. Label the different parts of your body. Can you see which bones are joined? Can you remember where the limbs and the joints are located?</p>	<p><b>Geography - Maps</b> Imagine you are a bird. Go around your home and take pictures of things from an aerial view.</p> 
<p><b>RE - The Creation Story</b> Draw pictures and write captions to show the 7 days of the Christian story of the Creation.</p>	<p><b>PSHE - Being Me</b> Draw a self-portrait or create a piece of 3D art to represent yourself. Make sure you can talk about it. Include your favourite colours to really capture you as a person.</p>	<p><b>Computing - Technology All Around us</b> Write an information poster telling someone the functions of a computer. Remember to include the mouse and keyboard.</p>

The above menu details a range of work for the subjects that your child will cover this term.
