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

Homework Challenge - Spring Term 1 2024

We would like children to select **at least one** of the homework challenges below for this half term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings, maths and English homework that are set each week.

<p>History - Ancient Rome</p>  <p>Investigate the key events and activities in Ancient Rome. Write a Newspaper article about Pompeii or a gladiator's victory at the Colosseum .</p>	<p>Science - States of Matter</p>  <p>Find out about how solids, liquids and gases all link together. Draw or create a labelled diagram showing these relationships, eg the water cycle, melting ice cubes, making jelly .</p>	<p>Geography - Eastern Europe</p>  <p>Find out key places and landscapes of Eastern Europe. Create an annotated 2d or 3d map of Eastern Europe. (or make a cake version !!)</p>
<p>French- Celebrations</p>  <p>Find out about festivals that are celebrated in France and how they are celebrated, eg Valentines Day and Easter. Create a poster to advertise one of these events, using some French words too</p>	<p>RE - Buddhism</p>  <p>Find out about Buddhism and the teachings of Buddha. Create a fact file or poster presenting your information.</p>	<p>PSHE - Dreams and Goals.</p>  <p>Understand the different hopes and dreams that we all have for the future. Produce a piece of inspirational work based on this theme. This could be a story, a poem or a piece of art work.</p>

The challenge work is due in the week beginning **12th Feb 2024**. The above menu details a range of work for the subjects that your child will cover this term in class.

Depending on the option they choose, children may choose to record their homework in a different way that doesn't involve using pen and paper, eg powerpoint, model or anything really!

We do ask that everyone has a go at this homework and chooses at least 1 from the menu so they all have something to share at the end of each term. Thank you for your continued support.
