### Homework Challenge – Summer 2, 2021

We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, spellings, maths and English homework that are set.

<p><b>Art – Investigating structures</b></p> <p>Sculpture is a 3-D art form, meaning that it is a piece of art that can be seen from all sides. Sculptures can be made from any materials.</p> <p>Make your own 3D sculpture - use your imagination!</p>	<p><b>Science – Magnetism</b></p> <p>Create a quiz for your class to take part in on magnetism.</p> <p>You could use lots of different types of questions: True or False? Multiple choice Short answer questions</p> <p>We will use your quiz at the end of the half term and you can be the quizmaster!</p>	<p><b>Maths – Time</b></p> <p>Make a clock with moving hands!</p> <p>Can you use it to help you tell o'clock times? What about half past times? Quarter past and quarter to?</p>
<p><b>English –</b></p> <p>Read 5 books off Oxford Owl at your reading level. <a href="https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/login?active-tab=students">https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/login?active-tab=students</a> Class or student username is <b>preston100</b> and the Password is <b>abcd</b>.</p> <p>Also write a list of the books that you have read. Give them a rating score out of 10. 1 is a poor book but 10 is a fab book. Can you explain why you gave each book its score?</p>	<p><b>History – Prehistoric Britain.</b></p> <p>Draw a picture of somebody who lived in either the Ice Age, Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age.</p> <p>Write some facts you have learnt about living in this period. I.e. How many years about was was this? What did people eat? Where did people live? Did they move around or did they live at the same place? What animals were around at the time? What tools did they use? What did they use them for?</p>	<p><b>PSHE – Changing me</b></p> <p>What is the life cycle of a human? Draw a picture of each stage of the life cycle and write a sentence or two to go with each stage. What can you do at each stage which you can't do at other stages? How does your body change at each stage?</p> <p><i>(Note for parents - The stages of a human life cycle are baby, toddler, childhood, adolescence, adulthood, and old age).</i></p>

The challenge work is due in on **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July** and during the week each child will get to present their work for it to be celebrated. The above menu details a range of work for the subjects that your child will cover this term.

The children will have their 'Homework Challenge book' to record their homework in if they wish. However, depending on the option they choose, the children may choose to record their homework in a different way that doesn't involve using their homework book. We do ask that everyone has a go at this homework, so they all have something to share at the end of each term. We thank you for your continued support.
