<p>Geography -South West England</p>  <p>Find out about the landscape and key places of the South West. Create an annotated 2d or 3d map of the area (this could be edible too if you are feeling creative !!)</p>	<p> Latin</p> <p>Mythology Competition Time -The Horse of Troy</p> <p>You could write a short story, a play, a retelling, a poem or any other creative written response in just 500 words and it should be submitted as a Word document not handwritten. Entries to Mrs Ryan before Wednesday 7th May 2025</p>	<p> PSHE -Relationships</p> <p>Understand the different relationships we are part of and learning how to deal with difficult emotions within those relationships.</p> <p>Produce a piece of inspirational work based on the PSHE theme. This could be a story, a poem or a piece of art work.</p>

The challenge work is due in on the week beginning **Monday 19th May 2025 to show. Parents/ Carers are invited in at this time to see the work produced.** The above ideas represent a range of work for the subjects that your child will cover this half term.
