We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular weekly homework.

<p>Art – Still Life</p> <p>Gather some still life items and draw them using colour, tone, cross-hatching and shading.</p> <p>Research the life of Cezanne.</p>	<p>Science – Matter and Materials</p> <p>Design a poster explaining the 3 states of matter – giving examples for each e.g. (liquid = water, gas = oxygen, solid = rock).</p> <p>Design and make something from paper, then explain why paper is the best material for your product.</p>	<p>History – The Romans</p> <p>Draw and label a Roman soldier in their armour.</p> <p>Bake Roman biscuits, you can find a recipe online.</p>
<p>Music – How does Music teach us about our neighbourhood?</p> <p>Create your own piece of music from household items.</p> <p>Ask someone from your family e.g. your grandad what is favourite song is. Listen to it and write down your opinions or compare it to your favourite song!</p>	<p>RE – Christianity – Easter-Resurrection</p> <p>To retell the story of Jesus' resurrection in a comic book style.</p> <p>Design your own Easter Egg and explain why we have Easter Eggs at Easter.</p>	<p>PSHE – Healthy Me</p> <p>Create a book explaining how we can keep our bodies healthy.</p> <p>Make a healthy menu for a days' worth of food, including breakfast, lunch, dinner and snacks.</p>
