Children will receive a piece of Maths or English homework on a **MONDAY** that we would like to be returned by the following **MONDAY**. Please upload a photo to Dojo or hand in the homework book.

Each **Friday**, children will be tested on a combination of mixed timetables to build up speed and accuracy ready for the Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) in June.

Children are expected to read <u>regularly</u> and this should be recorded in their reading record book by an adult or the child themselves. Ideally, at **least 3 times** per week is preferable to develop good reading speed and accuracy which are the building blocks for other subjects too.
