Children will receive a piece of Maths or English or EAAA homework on a Friday that we would like to be returned by the following Friday. Children can upload a photo to Dojo or hand in their homework book for checking.

Each Monday, children will now be tested on a combination of mixed timetables to build up their speed and accuracy. Please encourage your child to use the Tackling Tables website regularly to help with this.

It is hoped children would read <u>daily</u> and this should be recorded in their reading record book by an adult or the child themselves. Ideally, at <u>least 3 times</u> per week is preferable to developing good reading speed and accuracy.

Remember the homework challenge menu that is ongoing throughout the ½ term also!

Year 4: term 2.2

English

We will continue to look at our class fiction text Varjak Paw' by SF Said. We will then create our own versions of suspense stories as a class and then independently.

Later we will investigate persuasive writing and Create some of our own using the text 'Charlotte's Web' as a focus.

Maths

We are continuing to use the Maths mastery resources White Rose Maths.

We will learn the key concepts of understanding Decimals and look at how these link to our Fraction and Number knowledge. We will also spend a week securing knowledge of all 4 opperations and reading data from charts.
