We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this half term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading and weekly homework.

<p><b>History - The Anglo-Saxons</b></p>  <p>Find out about the significance of the Anglo-Saxons and what they achieved.</p> <p>Write a diary entry from the point of view of one of the villagers.</p>	<p><b>Science - Animal classification</b></p>  <p>Find out about animals from each of the classifications .</p> <p>Draw a labelled diagram of an insect, bird, mammal, amphibian, fish or reptile.</p>	<p><b>Geography - Spatial Sense</b></p>  <p>Find out how maps help us scale down a very large area..</p> <p>Create a map of the local area, including grid lines and references.</p>
<p><b>Computing- eSafety</b></p>  <p>Design a poster to promote e-safety.</p> <p>Write a set of e-safety rules that could be shared with all children in the school.</p>	<p><b>RE - Buddhism</b></p>  <p>Find out about the teachings of Buddha.</p> <p>Create a comic strip explaining a day in the life of a Buddhist, showing some of the routines and teachings they follow.</p>	<p><b>PSHE - Being me All About Me</b></p>  <p>Write an autobiograophy about your life so far.</p> <p>Draw a self portrait or create a piece of 3D art to represent yourself. Make sure you can talk about it.</p>

The challenge work is due in the week commencing **20<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER 2025**. The above menu details a range of work for the subjects that your child will cover this term.
