King's Lynn KLimate Concern

You may already be aware that later this year Glasgow will be hosting a very important climate change conference, **COP26**. Members of King's Lynn KLimate Concern have been working with a range of local organisations, including the borough council, to look at ways in which West Norfolk can reduce emissions in both domestic and business settings. Some of those members are going to Glasgow during COP26 and they very much want to take with them the thoughts of our children. To celebrate The Great Big Green Week, September 20th to 24th children are invited to enter their thoughts . The theme is **My message about Climate Change** and it can be in the form of a **Picture**, **Poster**, **Paragraph** or **Poem**. Messages should be on **one side of A4**, with the pupil's name, class and school shown clearly at the bottom of the page.

During the following week 27 Sept to 1 Oct, KLimate Concern will collect the messages and those considered to be the most powerful messages will be shortlisted. The Lynn News will select one message from each participating school and these will be printed in an album and presented at COP26 in Glasgow in November. A digital version of the album will also be made available to schools.

PE/After School Clubs.

This is for your information:- Pupils to be shown how to dress appropriately for PE (appropriate clothing, long hair tied back away from the eyes, no hard head accessories)

Earrings. Ideally pupils will remove earrings however, pupils unable to remove earrings should make them safe by taping, front and back, which may offer a measure of protection. The taping should be sufficient to prevent the stud post penetrating the bone behind the ear should an unintentional blow be received from equipment such as a ball or a person. The taping may be done at home for younger children (as stated Safe Practice in PE and School Sport and Physical Activity 2016).
