King's Lynn KClimate Concern

You may already be aware that later this year Glasgow will be hosting a very important climate change conference, **COP26**. Members of King's Lynn KClimate Concern have been working with a range of local organisations, including the borough council, to look at ways in which West Norfolk can reduce emissions in both domestic and business settings. Some of those members are going to Glasgow during COP26 and they very much want to take with them the thoughts of our children. To celebrate The Great Big Green Week, September 20th to 24th children are invited to enter their thoughts. The theme is **My message about Climate Change** and it can be in the form of a **Picture, Poster, Paragraph or Poem**. Messages should be on **one side of A4**, with the pupil's name, class and school shown clearly at the bottom of the page.

During the following week 27 Sept to 1 Oct, KClimate Concern will collect the messages and those considered to be the most powerful messages will be shortlisted. The Lynn News will select one message from each participating school and these will be printed in an album and presented at COP26 in Glasgow in November. A digital version of the album will also be made available to schools.

PE/After School Clubs.

This is for your information:- Pupils to be shown how to dress appropriately for PE (appropriate clothing, long hair tied back away from the eyes, no hard head accessories)

Earrings. Ideally pupils will remove earrings however, pupils unable to remove earrings should make them safe by taping, front and back, which may offer a measure of protection. The taping should be sufficient to prevent the stud post penetrating the bone behind the ear should an unintentional blow be received from equipment such as a ball or a person. The taping may be done at home for younger children (as stated Safe Practice in PE and School Sport and Physical Activity 2016).

Norfolk & Waveney Children's SaLT transferred to Cambridgeshire Community Services on 2nd August making closer working with Health Visitors, School Nurses and other Healthy Child Programme professionals much easier.

The service is being redesigned to better meet the needs for all children and young people in Norfolk and Waveney.

Priority changes

Agreed service priorities for the next year are:

- Reducing the waiting times whilst carrying on with essential work
- Joining speech and language therapy with Just One Number and Just One Norfolk so there is a single place to go for all speech and language therapy enquiries
- Developing the Balanced System® Framework for all speech, language and communication needs in Norfolk & Waveney



What is The Balanced System® framework?



A new way of working in Norfolk & Waveney to support families, caregivers and professionals to develop the skills and confidence needed to support children with speech, language and communication needs. This is a long term plan, developing with your support over the coming months.

Managing the waiting list

We are already working actively with 2400 children, families and the team around the child. There are approximately another 1500 children waiting for advice. The Speech and Language Therapy team will continue to work with children who need specialist support and are working hard to reduce waiting times.
