### PE/After School Clubs.

This is for your information:- Pupils to be shown how to dress appropriately for PE (appropriate clothing, long hair tied back away from the eyes, no hard head accessories)

**Earrings.** Ideally pupils will remove earrings however, pupils unable to remove earrings should make them safe by taping, front and back, which may offer a measure of protection. The taping should be sufficient to prevent the stud post penetrating the bone behind the ear should an unintentional blow be received from equipment such as a ball or a person. The taping may be done at home for younger children (as stated Safe Practice in PE and School Sport and Physical Activity 2016).

# CLENCHWARTON CREATIVE WRITING COMPETITION FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

(Lockdown tales)

Are you a budding writer and a good artist?

Clenchwarton Primary School and a local academic have teamed up to hold Clenchwarton's Creative Writing Competition, where you can write creatively about your experiences during lockdown and illustrate your story with a brilliant image or two. Did you learn a new skill, did you explore Clenchwarton and find out about anything new, have you learnt some new games? Tell us about it!

The competition is aimed at children of all school ages with special categories for Reception youngsters (4 & 5 year olds) right through to Key Stage 2 young people.

The creative story can either be biographical (inspired by your own life experiences) or fictional (made up from your imagination). But the theme needs to be related to lockdown & to your understanding and experience of it.

We want to hear your tales of Clenchwarton lockdown – perhaps you'll write about how you spent the time and how you overcame your difficulties (eg. Boredom, staying in touch with friends). We'd also love to hear about your successes - about how you kept going or took up a new hobby. Tell us about your hopes and aspirations for the future, now that school is fully open. What differences will the unlocking make to your life, going forward?

You decide how you want to craft a story that is unique to you.

We'd also love you to feel free to illustrate your work, if you want to. You can attach a drawing to your work or even accompany it with a photograph, if you prefer.

Work, together with illustrations, will be displayed on a special website set up for the occasion.

There are three entry categories, and winners in each age category will receive a special prize!

## The three entry categories are:

Reception Years: 4 – 5 year olds

Key Stage One: 5-7 year olds

Key Stage Two: 7 - 11 year olds

So get writing and get your entries & illustrations in ahead of the deadline, which is **Wednesday April 14 2021**.

If you have a chance, type your stories. But don't worry if you cannot do that. Handwritten stories are also welcome, and we'll type them up for you so they can be displayed online.


