This is for your information:- Pupils to be shown how to dress appropriately for PE (appropriate clothing, long hair tied back away from the eyes, no hard head accessories)

Earrings. Ideally pupils will remove earrings however, pupils unable to remove earrings should make them safe by taping, front and back, which may offer a measure of protection. The taping should be sufficient to prevent the stud post penetrating the bone behind the ear should an unintentional blow be received from equipment such as a ball or a person. The taping may be done at home for younger children (as stated Safe Practice in PE and School Sport and Physical Activity 2016).

Royal Shakespeare Company at St George's Guildhall

SGT will be showing a 'live theatre on film' production of the Royal Shakespeare Company performing William Shakespeare's Comedy of Errors on Friday 11th March 2022 at 7.30pm at St George's Guildhall, King's Lynn.



As part of its ongoing education and awareness programme, SGT is offering free tickets for under-18s, and discounted tickets for accompanying adults.

Adult tickets are at the reduced price of £5 (normal price £9.50) and up to two free under 18 tickets may be provided with each adult ticket purchased.

These tickets are being offered exclusively through local schools and numbers are limited and on a first-come-first-served basis.

The production is suitable for year 5 upwards, and a synopsis is below.

One of Shakespeare's early comedies, The Comedy of Errors is a fast-paced farce exploring mistaken identities and relations lost and found. This production was captured by Digital Theatre live at the Clapham Community Project. It was devised specifically for schools and families by the Royal Shakespeare Company in association with critically acclaimed theatre company, Told by an Idiot. Directed by Paul Hunter, it features a cast made up from the RSC's ensemble and uses a pared down script, props, live music and physical comedy to convey the story.
