Year 2 Trip to Ken Hill – Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2022

On Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2022 we will be taking our Year 2 pupils to Ken Hill. This will link nicely to their class topics of habitats in science. The children will go on a walk through the Ken Hill estate with the chance of meeting some animals that live in their own habitat. Then an afternoon session of a forest school in the Ken Hill estate.

The coach will be leaving the school at 9:15am therefore please ensure your child arrives at school for the usual time of 8:35am. All children must have a home or school packed lunch plus a healthy snack. If you require a school packed lunch, please order in the usual way (ParentPay) by 16<sup>th</sup> October. All pupils to wear old, suitable clothing (that you would not mind getting muddy). Also, appropriate footwear such as wellies, old trainers or boots to be worn too. We aim to return to the school in time for the usual pick up of 3:15pm. Please do bear with us if we are running slightly late due to traffic, we will try to keep you informed via text of any significant delays.

We are requesting a voluntary contribution of \*£8.00 per child towards the cost of this trip. No child would miss the event due to an unpaid contribution, however, in the event of low contributions, the event may have to be cancelled. If you have any concerns regarding payment, please see the school office or speak to Ms Borley.
