# **Keeping Children Safe Online:**

Did you know that you can get help setting parental controls on a range of devices at an O2 shop? Even if you are not an O2 customer, their specialist Gurus will help! From the O2 website:

"Most devices and some apps and games include parental controls. Understanding how these can be used to control in-app purchases as well as block upsetting or harmful content will help your children explore the online world safely. Parental controls need to be installed on your devices as well as managed inside the site social network app or game. You can get help setting these up by speaking to an O2 Guru by calling 0808 808 5002 for free, or visiting an O2 store. We can help whether you're an O2 customer or not. Remember parental controls are not fail safe and won't stop kids seeing inappropriate content on other devices. So it's always important to talk to your children about what they might see online."
