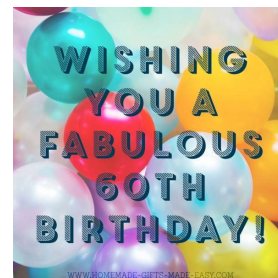
Hello everyone,

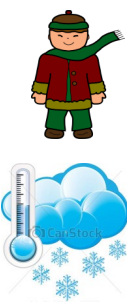
